SUMMARY: This collection documents the history of schools and education in Westport, Connecticut.

**HISTORICAL NOTE:** The Town of Westport was officially incorporated on May 28, 1835, but the area was settled by colonists as early as the late 17<sup>th</sup> century and schools existed from the 18<sup>th</sup> century. Westport currently has eight public schools: one high school (Staples High School), two middle schools (Bedford and Coleytown) and five elementary schools. Private schools that have existed in the town include Adams Academy, which was operated by Ebenezer Adams from 1837 to 1867. For more detailed history about schools and education in Westport, see documents in Series I.

**SCOPE AND CONTENT:** The development and history of schools in Westport, both private and public, is documented from the late 18<sup>th</sup> century onwards. Series I contains material related to education and schools in general in the town, arranged chronologically. Series 2 is organized alphabetically by the names of specific schools. For additional documentation related to the Adams Academy, see Record Group 9, Adams Family Papers.
